The Oxnard Fire Department protects life, property, and the environment through a full range of professional services: fire suppression, emergency medical response, community risk reduction, Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) services, hazardous materials operations, urban search and rescue, disaster preparedness, and code enforcement. Serving a diverse population across urban, coastal, industrial, and agricultural settings, the Department plays a vital role in advancing the City's vision for safety and resilience.

## THE ROLE – FIRE MARSHAL

Reporting directly to the Fire Chief, the Fire Marshal serves as a key executive leader and member of the Fire Department's management team. The Fire Marshal oversees the Fire Prevention Division and the CUPA, managing a team of approximately 19 staff while shaping community fire and life safety.











### **CORE RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Advance Fire & Life Safety Enforce codes through inspections, plan reviews, permits, and compliance programs.
- Lead Prevention & Risk Reduction Direct and develop Fire
  Prevention personnel in all aspects of community risk
  reduction strategies.
- Oversee Hazardous Materials & CUPA Provide oversight of hazardous materials regulation and CUPA programs (with an established CUPA Manager in place).
- **Drive Investigations** Oversee fire and arson investigations in partnership with law enforcement.
- Champion Public Education Lead outreach programs that engage and educate residents and businesses.
- Advise Leadership Serve as a trusted advisor on prevention policies and risk management.
