Directions to the Community & Cultural Center

The Center is located at the corner of Monterey Road and East Dunne Avenue at 17000 Monterey Road. Public parking is available in the parking lot immediately behind the facility.

From the North

- Exit Highway 101 at East Dunne Avenue.
- Turn right on East. Dunne and travel for approximately one mile.
- The center will be on the right side of the street, shortly after crossing the railroad tracks.

From the South

- Exit Highway 101 at East Dunne Avenue.
- Turn left on East Dunne, cross over the highway, and travel for approximately one mile.
- The center will be on the right side of the street, shortly after crossing the railroad tracks.
